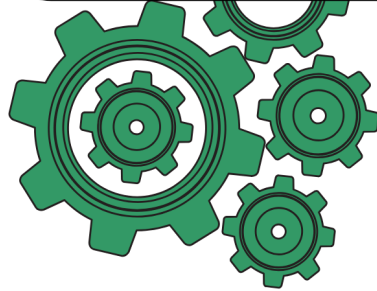

BROCCOLI CORNBREAD

- 1/4 cup margarine, melted
- 1/3 cup onion, chopped
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 3/4 cup low fat cottage cheese
- 1 1/2 cups fresh broccoli, finely chopped
- 4 eggs, beaten
- 1 (8.5 oz) box quick corn muffin mix

- Preheat oven to 400 degrees F. In a mixing bowl, blend melted margarine, onion, salt, cheese, broccoli and eggs. Stir in muffin mix.
- Pour into greased 9x13 inch pan
- Bake for 20 to 25 minutes, until the top is golden brown. Cool and cut into squares.
